## Most Frequently Asked Questions

1. Where is the Luau Cove?

Luau Cove is located on the west beach of Disney's Polynesian Resort past the marina. From the Great Ceremonial House, past Captain Cook's on the first floor and follow the signs to the Luau Cove.

2. Where can I find Disney transportation?

The monorail is located on the second

The monorail is located on the second floor of the Great Ceremonial House and makes stops at Disney's Grand Floridian Resort & Spa, the Magic Kingdom® Park, Disney's Contemporary Resort and the Transportation and Ticket Center before returning to Disney's Polynesian Resort. The express monorail to Epcot® loads at the nearby Transportation and Ticket Center. Buses to the Downtown Disney area, Typhoon Lagoon, Blizzard Beach, Disney-MGM Studios and Disney's Animal Kingdom® Theme Park are located near The Never Land Club at the Bus Stop. Motor launch transportation to the Magic Kingdom® via Disney's Grand Floridian Resort & Spa is located at the end of the marina dock.

3. Where is the Best Friends Character Breakfast, and who will be there?

Breakfast featuring Best Friends Lilo and Stitch along with Mickey Mouse and Pluto is served each morning at 'Ohana located on the second floor of the Great Ceremonial House from 7:30 a.m. to 10:45 a.m.

4. Where can I purchase stamps and where is the mailbox?

Stamps may be purchased in the Great Ceremonial House at the BouTiki gift shop. Mailboxes are located near the Concierge desk and by Wyland Galleries. Federal Express shipping is available. 5. Where is Lost and Found and what are the hours?

Lost and Found is located in the Great Ceremonial House at the Concierge desk and is open Tuesday through Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. After-hours assistance is provided at Concierge. For inquiries, Touch FRONT DESK or CONCIERGE on your in-room phone.

6. Where can I make dining arrangements or purchase tickets?
